

HIP Retirees Get New Mail-Order Pharmacy Provider

Effective January 1, 2008, HIP retirees who use the mail-order pharmacy will have their prescriptions filled by Medco rather than Express Scripts. In most cases, if your mail-order prescription with Express Scripts has available refills, it will be transferred to MEDCO. If, however, your prescription is a compound medication or for a controlled substance, it can not be transferred, and you will need to obtain new prescriptions. You may call Medco at 1-800-820-9726 to obtain refills and determine if your prescription was transferred. You will need your current Express Scripts prescription number when calling for a refill of an existing prescription.
